ICE-BREAKER

Who is the most famous person you have ever met? What happened?

GROUP DISCUSSION...

1. What is your most valued material possession? How do you treat it? What insight does that give you into how you should value others?
2. READ Philippians 2:3-4. What are some specific ways you can “value others more than yourself”? How does this apply specifically to your spouse?
3. How do you see “selfish ambition” or “vein conceit” slipping into your relationship? What can you do to guard against these things?
4. READ Philippians 2:5-8. Describe a time when you saw someone with position or power choose to serve rather than to leverage that position or status for their own benefit? How did that make you feel? Were you surprised by their action?
5. Who do you know (*besides Jesus*) that actually lives like Paul describes in this chapter? What have you observed about their life? What is their secret?
6. Pastor Josh said, “*There’s a huge difference between “being right” and “making a difference.”*” Do you agree or disagree? What is more important to you in your relationship? How does that show up in your life?
