ICE-BREAKER...

If you were to write a book what would it be about?

GROUP DISCUSSION...

1. Have you ever tried to find meaning and purpose apart from Jesus? What kinds of things do you pursue to find meaning for your soul?
2. **READ John 4:3-6.** “Jesus HAD to pass through Samaria...” Has God ever created a divine appointment to help you find healing or encouragement? Has God ever created a divine appointment to use to bring healing or encouragement to someone else?
3. **READ John 4:7-15.** Compare and contrast the kind of water that Jesus is talking about and the water that the woman is talking about? What does it mean that you will “*never thirst again?*”
4. **READ John 4:16-26.** How is Jesus’ statement in verse 16 a turning point in the conversation? Why does Jesus bring up this sensitive personal information? How would you have responded to Jesus if you were in the woman’s position?
5. How have you experienced Jesus bring healing and freedom from your past?
6. How can we “worship the Father in Spirit and in truth”? What does that look like in our everyday lives?
7. Jesus went out of his way to extend grace to the Samaritan woman. What people or group of people is God calling you to go out of your way to extend grace to this week?
