5. **READ Judges 16:23-31.** How have you seen God accomplish HIS purpose in spite of your failures? What does it mean to you to fail forward?
6. **Pastor Josh said, "Failure is an event, NEVER a person."** Do you agree or disagree? How does this idea influence the way that you look at others? How does it influence the way you see yourself? How will this idea help you deal with future failures?
