4. **READ Malachi 3:6-12.** In every other situation God does not like it when His people test him. Why would God tell us to test Him when it comes to our finances? Have you ever tested God in your giving? What happened?
5. Who is the most generous person you know? How did they become so generous? When you think about your own generosity journey what factors have made you more or less generous?
6. As we wrap up this Aliens series, what is the main thought or idea that has stuck with you?
